City of Waverly Face Mask Policy

On August 3, 2020 the Waverly City Council passed a resolution requiring any member of the public to wear a face mask while being an occupant of a public building.

Face masks MUST be worn by the public in the following Leisure Services facilities:

City Hall/Civic Center - *This includes all public meetings and private party events held in the Civic Center.*

Golf Pro Shop - *Required while inside the Pro Shop at all times. Limit of 4 customers in the Pro Shop at any time. Face masks will not be required on the golf course.*

Golf Maintenance Facility, Parks Shop, Cemetery Office - *Masks required while inside these facilities.*

Additionally: All City of Waverly employees will be required to wear a mask when interacting with the public or other employees unless social distancing of 6 feet or more can occur.

While City Hall remains open to the public, we strongly encourage customers to make appointments or communicate via telephone, email or postal mail as often as possible to minimize public interaction.

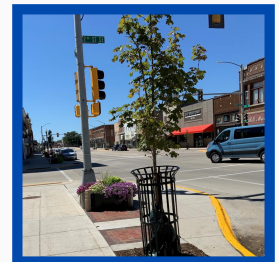
KEEPING BUSY....
