- 3. Plaques for the Waverly Historic Registry will be presented during Heritage Days events in honor of the 150th Celebration of Waverly.
- Historic Preservation Month is May. Meyer-Reyerson suggested a City Council proclamation, as in past years. The commissioners agreed.
