1. Buyout homes:

Payne stated that she recently met with officials from INRCOG. She found out that salvage done through a non-profit is less complicated and, in allowing only non-profits to salvage, INRCOG may be able to allow salvage without going through the bidding process. She shared with INRCOG that the commission supports a non-profit salvage of the buyout homes. Then Commission will ask INRCOG for first preference to be given to moving the home, then preference given to non-profits to salvage.

As soon as the waiver to enter homes is drafted, commissioners want to enter and evaluate the salvage potential of available buyout homes.

Preservation Iowa has indicated that they are willing to do salvage work and try to provide the items for Waverly area restoration projects.

Hundley made a motion that Payne be asked to represent the commission in further discussions with INRCOG regarding the handling of buyout properties.
