7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1905 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with similar houses in Waverly built using this form from ca. 1890-1930. Property Transfer Records show this parcel transferred to W.J Epson by Charles Dittmer in 1909. Use of concrete block rather than stone confirms a post-1905 construction date. The 1913 city directory shows Walter Epson and his wife Dora residing here. Public records suggest a construction date of ca. 1909.

This house is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house has a rock-faced concrete block foundation and the walls are clad in narrow clapboard-style vinyl siding. The house has a steeply pitched hipped roof with narrow eaves. A gabled wall dormer is on the south façade above the front porch and a later shed-roof attic dormer is on the west façade. A broad gable-roofed enclosed porch spans most of the front façade. It has matching vinyl siding and a concrete block foundation on the walls with an entrance door centered between 1/1 windows. The porch was added after original construction and included 3/1 double-hung windows when built. In ca. 2010, the current wall finishes and windows were completed after the flood of 2008. Windows on the main house are 1/1 double-hung units.

The house has a 1-story detached double-bay garage constructed north of the house in ca. 2010. It has a front-gable roof, twin overhead doors and matching vinyl siding.

Alterations: vinyl siding (2010); porch enclosure, (2010); garage, (2010).

8. Significance

The Walter and Dora Empson House was built in ca. 1909 or slightly earlier and is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

Property Transfer Records show this parcel transferred to W.J Epson by Charles Dittmer in 1909. By 1913, Walter Empson and his wife Dora resided here. Walter had no occupation at the time making it possible that the couple were retired. In 1944, the property passed to Blanche Gaffney who held it until after she married and became Blanche Perkins. She sold it in 1945 to John and Yvonne Gambaiani. They held it until 1950 when it was sold to Louis and Darlen Gambaiani who held it for some years.

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


