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7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1940 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built at the 1930s and 1940s. Property transfer records show the parcel was acquired by Cora Ebert, daughter of George and Anna Ebert, in 1940 from Mary and Fred Kappmeyer. The first listing for the Ebert family at this address in the phone book came in 1943. A construction date of ca. 1940 is consistent with other similarly designed houses in the neighborhood.

This 1-story frame house is an example of a Bungalow Style, Front-Gabled Roof house form. The Ebert House has a parged clay tile block foundation with asbestos shingle siding on the walls. A broad front-gable roof has narrow eaves and no cornice boards. A low-pitched front-gabled porch is on the right side of the front façade and was originally built as an enclosed space.

Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced 3/1 double-hung Craftsman Style windows of various sizes with vertical lights in the upper sashes. The window group in the front gable includes smaller 3/1 windows flanking a taller 3/1 window. Pairs of 3/1 windows are along the south façade. The porch has a continuous row of 3/1 along the north and west facades with the main entrance on the south side centered between narrow 2/1 sash.

A detached frame single-bay garage is located at the rear of the property east of the house. It has a moderate pitched front gable roof and a single overhead door. It is clad in clapboard-style vinyl siding. The building was constructed in 2010 according to Assessor records

Alterations: siding (undated); garage (2010); foundation parging (undated).

8. Significance

The Ebert House at 518 2nd St NW was built in ca. 1940. It is an example of a Bungalow Style, Front-Gabled Roof house form. The plan is an example of infill housing built throughout the neighborhood on small lots at the end of the 1930s and continuing through the end of World War II. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C. The garage is considered noncontributing because of its recent construction.

Property transfer records show the parcel was acquired by Cora Ebert, daughter of George and Anna Ebert, in 1940 from Mary and Fred Kappmeyer. The first listing for the Ebert family at this address in the phone book came in 1943 when George and Anna resided here. By 1948, George was deceased but Anna continued to reside here. She was the principal occupant until the late 1950s. The 1961 city directory shows Cora Ebert, an instructor at Wartburg College, residing here as the owner.



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
