### 7. Description

This house is estimated to have been built in 1930 according to Bremer County Assessor records. This date is consistent with the design and form of the house as well as newspaper accounts dating from January and December 1930 construction season referring to Fred Hay's house going up for a cost of \$8,500.

The Hay House is an example of a Colonial Revival Side-Gabled 2-Story house form. The house has a concrete block foundation and mottled red, gray, tan and brown brick walls laid in a common bond. The house has a moderate pitched side-gable roof on the 2-story portion of the house and a flat roof surrounded by a pipe railing on the 1-story south wing. The gables of the main block have returning cornices. A shallow projecting entrance bay is symmetrically located on the west façade and features a pediment roof with a semi-circular arched vault and a paneled fanlight in the recessed tympanum. An exposed brick chimney pierces the gable peak on the north façade.

Fenestration includes single and paired double-hung windows of various sizes with three vertical lights in the upper sashes and a single light in the lower sash. The single and double-wide window openings on each level have soldier brick forming the lintels.

Originally, the house was built with a single-bay attached garage located in the south wing. In 1972 according to Assessor records, the present frame double-bay garage was built. It has a broad gable roof with the overhead door facing south. The garage is attached to the main house by a narrow connection.

Alterations: garage conversion (1972); new garage (1972).

### 8. Significance

The Hay House at 518 3<sup>rd</sup> St NW is an example of an example of a Colonial Revival Side-Gabled 2-Story house form. The house was built on the eve of the Great Depression as the 2<sup>rd</sup> Ward continued to experience infill housing in the J.J. Smith Addition. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as an individually significant property under Criterion A and C and as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.

LaVern "Fred" Hay acquired this vacant parcel from Fred Scharnhorst in early 1930 and by November the house on North Linn Street (3<sup>rd</sup> St NW) was complete. He and his wife, Lucy, resided here into the 1940s. In 1955, the house was sold to Walter and Leona Neubauer who sold it two years later to Karl F. Weltner, a minister. He resided here with Lillian Weltner, a seamstress at the Lutheran Children's Home. Later Karl was a teacher at Waverly-Shell Rock High School. He died in 1971 and the property passed to Waldemar and Esther Gies.


