7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1958 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built during the 1950s and 1960s. Property transfer records show that Lewis and Geneva Williams acquired this property in June 1959. Lewis Williams is listed in the 1959 telephone book at this address suggesting the house was completed the previous year or before the family purchased the home. Together these sources confirm a construction date of 1958.

This 1-story brick house is an example of a classic Ranch/Rambler house form with the attached garage at one end, public space in the middle, and private space (bedrooms) in the opposite end. The Williams House has a concrete block foundation with solid color dark red brick walls. The long horizontal form is topped by a low-pitched hipped-roof with wide eaves. A recessed entrance bay takes advantage of the wide eaves to form a protected stoop. The house was originally built with a single-bay garage at the south end, which it retains in 2013.

Fenestration throughout the house includes a mix of 1/1 double-hung windows of various sizes in singles and pairs. On the front façade, a modified Chicago window group to the left of the recessed entrance has narrow casement windows (replacements of the original 1/1 double-hung sash) flanking a large, single-light "picture window." A pair of short 1/1 double-hung windows are to the right of the entrance bay with similar single window units on the north façade.

An attached single-bay garage with a low-pitched hipped roof is at the south end. It is clad in the same finishes as the house. It retains its original wood and glass paneled overhead door with a passage door along the south wall. It was constructed in 1958 when the balance of the house was built according to Assessor.

Alterations: casement window installation, undated.

8. Significance

The Lewis and Geneva Williams House at 523 3rd St NW was built in 1959 and is a well-preserved example of a Ranch/Rambler house form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

According to property transfer records, Lewis and Geneva Williams acquired this property on June 1, 1959 from Mary and George Harlan. Telephone directories for 1959 show the Williams family in residence and by 1961, the first city directory listing for the property shows Lewis with no occupation making it likely that this was a retirement home for the couple. It is likely the house was occupied as a retirement home for the couple. In 1967 after Lewis passed away, the property was transferred by Lewis' estate to Norman and Geneva Johansen. The following year it was sold to Leslie and Claribel Hastings who resold it in 1972 to Larry and Sylvia Williams.


