7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1948 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form is typical of the small and compact infill houses in Waverly built during the late 1930s and 1940s. In June 1945 Bremer County Property Transfer Records show Robert and Winifred Ecker acquiring this property making it likely the house was built soon after acquisition. Therefore, a construction date of ca. 1948 is consistent with public records for this property.

This 1½-story frame house is an example of a vernacular Minimal Traditional Side-Gable Roof house form. In this case the house has salt-box shape with the rear half 2-stories in height and the front half having only one story with an extended slope. This house has a concrete block foundation with walls clad in narrow clapboard-style vinyl siding. The house has a moderate pitched side-gable roof with narrow eaves. The entrance is recessed and set slightly off center. Fenestration includes single, paired and triple single-light casement windows of various sizes that are undated replacements. The house retains its original front door with three short vertical lights above a pair of tall panels.

The property has two frame double-car garages south of the main house. One was built in 1994 and the other in 2003 according to Assessor records. One is attached and the other is detached but both have front-gable roofs, matching siding, double-wide overhead garage doors. One of the garages likely serves as storage for the Ecker Greenhouse/Florist Shop located to the south on Block 44.

Alterations: Aluminum siding (undated); a metal awning extends over the front steps.

8. Significance

The Robert and Winifred Ecker House at 415 4th Ave NW built in ca. 1948 is an example of a vernacular Minimal Traditional Side-Gable Roof house form typical of the economical and efficient plans introduced during the 1930s and 1940s by pattern book and plan bureaus seeking to provide creative small house designs for the Great Depression and World War years. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C while the garages are considered noncontributing because of recent construction dates.

Robert and Winifred Ecker acquired this property in June 1945 from John P. Wright and his wife Bess. This followed a sale the previous year when the Wrights sold the Waverly Greenhouse business to the Eckers as well. In July 1948, Robert and Winifred sold 415 4th Ave NW to Theodore Ecker. It is not clear whether Robert and Winifred or Ted Ecker built this residence but after 1948 and into the 1950s, Ted and his wife Barbara resided here. Various members of the Ecker family continued to hold the property at least into the 1990s.



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
