7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1888 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from the 1860s to the 1890s. The property was part of a multi-lot parcel (Lots 6, 7, & 8, Block 52) transferred to members of the Dean family by a combination of warranty deed, treasurer's deed and sheriff's deed between 1867 and 1882. The 1868 *Bird's Eye View of the City of Waverly* depicts a house with the same form at the intersection of 4th Ave and 5th St suggesting the house is 20 years older than estimated by the Assessor's record. Additional research will need to be completed on the value of the property at transfer points to identify an approximate date of construction. An earlier date than 1888 is anticipated.

This frame dwelling is an example of a vernacular Gable-Front and Wing 1-story house form. The Pitcher House has a parged stone foundation with wide clapboard-style vinyl and steel siding. The front-gable section has a moderate-pitched roof with narrow eaves and the side-gabled west wing has a slightly lower pitch. The original porch filling the left-hand ell has been removed and replaced with a wood deck with no roof or balustrade. Original window openings remain but the 4/4 double-hung units present originally and up until ca. 2007, were replaced with 6/6 double-hung units. The feature window group includes a flat roofed rectilinear bay window centered on the gable end of the south façade. It has a pair of double-hung window openings previously containing 4-light sashes.

A double-bay detached frame garage is located on the north side of the house. It is clad in matching siding and was constructed in 1960 according to Assessor records. It has a low-pitched front-gable roof with a deep overhang on the front supported by diagonal brackets extending to ground level. A single double-wide overhead door opens onto 5th St NW.

Alterations: siding, undated; garage, 1960; porch removal, undated; replacement windows.

8. Significance

The Luther and Harriet Pitcher House at 502 4th Ave NW was built as early as ca. 1868 or as late as the 1880s. It is an example of an early vernacular Gable-Front and Wing house form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

According to property transfer records, the property was part of a multi-lot parcel (Lots 6, 7, & 8, Block 52) transferred to members of the Dean family by a combination of warranty deed, treasurer's deed and sheriff's deed between 1867 and 1882. The first family member was George A. Dean who acquired the three lots in 1867, followed by H.V. Dean in 1880, and Daniel Dean in 1886. Other Dean family members offered quit claim deeds to the lots. The 1868 *Bird's Eye View of the City of Waverly* depicts a house with the same form at the intersection of 4th Ave and 5th St suggesting the house was built soon after George Dean acquired it in 1867.

In 1893, Daniel Dean transferred his interest in Lot 8 to Luther S. Pitcher, who was listed as a farmer in the 1895 lowa Census. His wife Harriet was identified as a housekeeper. The 1899 city directory lists

L.S. Pitcher as a janitor. When the 1913 city directory was published, Luther and Hattie still resided at 502 Fremont St but no occupation was listed for Luther. By then, he would have been 74 years old and likely retired. Property transfer records become unclear for Lot 8 in subsequent years until its ownership is transferred from Charity West to Amos West in 1940 and then to Josephine B. Miller from Amos' estate. In 1946, Josephine and her husband sell it to Robert and Gladys Dempsey who holds it briefly before transferring it to John J. Becker in 1947.




