### 7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1890 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from the 1860s through the 1890s. The property was acquired in July 1891 by L.S. Pitcher who lived a block to the east at 502 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. Pitcher's house was nearly identical but with a reverse plan. Pitcher sold two years later to Charles F. Sinderson. The house at 602 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW is clearly depicted on the 1894 Sanborn Map at the northwest corner of Fremont and Aspen (4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW and 6<sup>th</sup> St NW). A ca. 1891 date of construction is consistent with public records.

This frame dwelling is an example of a vernacular Gable-Front and Wing 1½ and 1-story house form. The Sinderson House has a parged stone foundation with stucco cladding. The front-gable section has a moderate-pitched roof with narrow eaves and the side-gabled west wing has a lower pitch. The original porch filling the right-hand ell has been reduced in size. It has a flat roof with a balustrade composed of square spindles and square columns at the outside corners. Most of the original window openings remain with 1/1 double-hung units present. A window change includes installation of a pair of short 1/1 units on the side-gable wing. The house has applied shutters on most openings.

A single-bay detached frame garage is located on the north side of the house. It is clad in vertical tongue and groove siding and was constructed in 1997according to Assessor records. It has a low-pitched front-gable roof with deep eaves. A single-wide overhead door opens onto 5<sup>th</sup> St NW.

Alterations: siding, undated; garage, 1997; porch alterations, undated; replacement windows.

### 8. Significance

The Charles and Mary Sinderson House at 502 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW was built in ca. 1891. It is an example of a vernacular Gable-Front and Wing house form built in this neighborhood from the 1860s to the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

According to property transfer records, the property was acquired in July 1891 by L.S. Pitcher, a laborer, who lived a block to the east at 502 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW in a nearly identical but with a reverse plan. Pitcher sold the house at 602 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW in July 1893 to Charles F. Sinderson. The house at 602 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW is clearly depicted on the 1894 Sanborn Map at the northwest corner of Fremont and Aspen (4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW and 6<sup>th</sup> St NW). Charles and his wife Mary are listed in the 1895 lowa Census as residing in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward but no specific location can be confirmed.

Four years later in 1897, Sinderson sold both Lots 7 and 8 to Peter Dalton and his wife Sarah. The house was a retirement home for the couple according to the 1899 city directory. In 1909 following her husband's death, Sarah sold the house on Lot 8 to Maude Blain who transferred the same property two years later in 1911 to Adeline Miller (Mrs. C.A. Miller) who was listed in the 1913 city directory as residing there. In April 1913, Adeline, a widow, sold the house to Lena Bessmer who held it until 1918 when it was transferred to Carrie Manuel (spelling unclear in transfer records).

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By 1928 the house had transferred to John Hamm and his wife who that year sold it to Joseph Guter. The 1931 telephone book shows Guter and his wife Anna living at 602 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. The house remained in the Guter family until after Anna's death when the estate transferred it to Lawrence and Gerald Guter. New owners in 1995 were Robert and Malissa Cousin who also owned the Lot 7 next door.


