7. Description

This house is estimated to have been built in 1934 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house was transferred from A.C. Grossmann to Cora Ebert in April 1934. It may be that Cora's father, George Ebert, a building contractor, was responsible for building the house. The address for this house is not depicted on the 1927 Sanborn Map. A construction completion date of ca. 1934 is consistent for the design and materials found in this house as well as transfer records for the property.

This 1½-story frame dwelling is an example of a vernacular Front-Gabled Roof house form with an L-shaped plan. The house has a clay tile block foundation and medium-width clapboard-style steel siding on the walls. The tile block is a dark reddish brown color and was likely manufactured at one of the Mason City brick and tile companies. The moderate-pitched intersecting gable roof has a prominent broad gable on the front wing with a lower pitch on the enclosed front-gable porch. Based on an examination of the 1943 Sanborn Map, it is likely that the original design that included a porch of only half the size of the current one at the south end of the front façade, had a contiguous front-gable roof. A wider porch was added at a later date and now is fully enclosed and incorporated into interior space of the main house. Fenestration includes a mix of 1/1 double-hung window units with sliding windows incorporated into the enclosed front porch. The main entrance is located on the south side of the front porch. The major window change in the past decade was the removal of a three-part segmental arched unit in the front gable by a pair of single-light sliding windows with a flat top.

A double-bay detached frame garage is located parallel to the alley with the overhead door facing east. The garage was built in 1976 according to Assessor records. It has siding that matches that of the house.

A pair of stone pillars is located at the southeast and northeast corners of the property. They have concrete caps and likely date from 1934 or earlier.

Alterations: siding, undated; porch expanded and enclosed, undated.

8. Significance

The Cora Ebert House at 611 4th St NW is an example of a vernacular Front-Gabled Roof house form. The house was likely built in ca. 1934 by George Ebert, Cora's father. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as contributing resource to the Harmon and LeValley NW Historic District under Criteria A and C. The garage is considered noncontributing.

According to property transfer records, Cora Ebert acquired this parcel in April 1934 from A.C. Grossmann. She held the house and most likely occupied it until she sold it in 1943 to Albert and Dorothy Klein. As an aside, Cora moved in with her parents that year at 518 2nd St NW. She eventually became an instructor at Wartburg College. The Kleins held the house briefly after buying it from Cora, reselling it a year later in 1944 to Ernest and Marie Mueller. After Marie's death, it passed to Herbert and Claudette Meyer in 1963.




