7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1896 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from ca. 1890 through the 1910s. Property transfer records show this property was sold by Charles O. Smith to Christian Thoren in July 1896. A house at this address appears in the 1913 city directory listings as occupied by John C. Pries who acquired the house from Thoren's widow, Amelia, in February 1910. A construction date of ca. 1896 appears consistent with public records.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house has a parged stone foundation with asbestos shingle siding on the walls. A low-pitched hipped roof has no dormers and narrow eaves. A small enclosed entrance bay with a low-pitched front-gable roof was added to the front façade sometime after publication of the 1952 Sanborn Map, most likely at the same time as installation of asbestos shingle siding. Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced single and paired 1/1 double-hung windows. A single horizontal window is located in the enclosed entrance bay.

The property has two garages. One was built in 1923 according to property transfer records. It is located east of the house and has a single bay, beveled wood siding with a hipped roof, and 2/2 double-hung windows. The second garage located southeast of the house has vertical metal siding with a double-bay overhead door and wide front-gable roof. The first garage is a contributing resource and the second is noncontributing.

Alterations: asbestos siding (undated); enclosed front entrance bay (undated).

8. Significance

The Thoren House at 311 5th Ave NW built in ca. 1896 is an example of vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. It is typical of similar houses built at the turn of the 20th century. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C. One garage built in 1923 is considered contributing and the other noncontributing.

Property transfer records show this property was sold by Charles O. Smith (relationship to subdivision platter J.J. Smith unknown) to Christian Thoren on July 9, 1896. No house appears to be occupied by Chris Thoren and his wife, Amelia, when the 1899 city directory was published, however. In 1904 Christian Thoren, likely a farmer in Warren Township, died and his wife, Amelia, followed in 1910. John C. Pries acquired the house from Amelia Thoren in February 1910, and was listed as occupying the house with his wife, Dorothea (Dora), when the 1913 city directory was published. No occupation was listed for John suggesting he may have been retired at the time. He also may have owned or worked at one of the several Pries farms near Waverly.


