7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1920 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from the 1890s through the World War I period. The parcel was transferred in December 1912 from G. and E. Seifert to Herman Warnke. The 1913 city directory lists Warnke and his wife Martha residing at 602 Fulton (5th Ave NW). A construction date of ca. 1913 appears to be more accurate.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form commonly built before and after 1900. The house has a parged concrete block foundation and wide clapboard-style vinyl siding on the walls. The main block of the house has a low-pitched hipped roof with no dormers and moderate width eaves. The front porch spans the full front and has a shed roof. It has been rebuilt with new turned posts at the outer corners and entrance steps, turned spindles in the balustrade, a new wood deck, and no skirting. Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced single 1/1 double-hung windows. The front door is set slightly off-center.

A detached frame single-bay garage is located at the rear of the house and opens onto the alley. According to Assessor records, the garage was constructed in 1977.

Alterations: vinyl siding (undated); rebuilding of porch (undated); window replacement (undated).

8. Significance

The Warnke House at 602 5th Ave NW was built in ca. 1913 and vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. It is typical of several other houses built along 5th Ave NW and intersecting streets before and after 1900 in this section of the Harmon and LeValley neighborhood. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C and the garage is considered noncontributing.

Gottgetreu and Elisabeth Seifert transferred Lot 8 in Block 56 of Knott's Addition to Herman Warnke in December 1912. The house was built a short time later and Herman and his wife Martha lived here briefly before selling it in February 1913 to Sophia Lageschulte. She held it until 1920 selling it to Tom McClusky. In 1943 Tom McClusky's estate passed the house to his wife Katherine. It is not clear whether or not the McClusky's resided here or rented the house.






