### 7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1948 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built after World War II. A house first appears in the 1952 Sanborn Map. The property was owned by Fred Seeman and his wife Mary beginning in 1900 and transferred to Arlo Courbat in October 1939. He transferred the property to Donald Schoof in 1948 who may have undertaken construction of the house. By 1954 the property was held by Henry and Marie Hay and they were residing at this address according to the 1954 telephone directory. Together these public records suggest that the house was erected between ca. 1948 and ca. 1950.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular 1-story Minimal Traditional house form. This variation has a detached garage. The house has a concrete block foundation with wide clapboard-style aluminum siding on the walls. The house has a moderate-pitched side-gable roof with shallow eaves on the slopes and no eaves on the gable ends. A shed-roofed wing and cutaway porch is formed by an extension of the front roof slope.

Fenestration includes single 2/2 double-hung windows of several sizes with horizontal lights. Single windows are symmetrically placed on the gabled ends with a variation of a Chicago window group as the feature window in the projecting front wing. It consists of a large square fixed sash flanked by 2/2. (horizontal lights) double-hung units. The original single-bay garage is southeast of the east gable end wall. According to Assessor records, it was constructed in 1951. It has vertical tongue-and-groove boards for the siding and the original wagon-style garage doors still in place.

Alterations: aluminum siding (undated); garage (1951).

### 8. Significance

The Hay House at 609 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NW was built in ca. 1950 is an example of a Minimal Traditional house form from the post World War II period. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

The property was owned by Fred Seeman and his wife Mary beginning in 1900 and transferred to Arlo Courbat in October 1939. He transferred the property to Donald Schoof in 1948 who may have undertaken construction of the house a short time later. By 1954 the property was owned by Henry and Marie Hay, retired farmers. They were listed in telephone directories at this house beginning in 1954.




