7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1888 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built during the 1870s-1910s period. A house at this address appears on the 1894 Sanborn Map and is listed in the 1899 city directory listings as occupied by Mary Garner, widow of Eugene. Property transfer records show Charles Garner acquiring Lots 5 & 6 in Block 45 in October 1885. No house is at this address in the 1885 lowa Census but Eugene and Mary Garner with their three children are residing in the 2nd Ward in the 1895 lowa Census. Together these public records suggest that the house was erected sometime after 1885. A construction date of ca. 1888 is consistent with public records.

This 2-story frame house is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 2-story house form. The house has a parged stone foundation with narrow clapboard-style vinyl siding on the walls. A low-pitched hipped roof has no dormers and moderate width eaves. The enclosed entrance porch is centered on the front and has a broad front gable roof with the walls clad in matching vinyl siding. Single 1/1 windows flank the centered entrance. Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced single 1/1 double-hung windows with wide crown moldings. A feature window group is on the south façade and includes four windows set in a hip-roofed angular bay window.

A detached frame double-bay garage has a broad front-gable roof with a single overhead door. Assessor records say the garage was erected in 1990.

Alterations: vinyl siding (undated); garage (1990).

8. Significance

The Garner House at 302 5th St NW was built in ca. 1888 and is an example of vernacular Hipped Roof, 2-story house form. It is typical of several other similar houses built during the latter years of the 19th century in this neighborhood. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C and the garage is considered noncontributing.

Property transfer records show this parcel transferred to Charles Garner in October 1885. No house is at this address in the 1885 Iowa Census but Eugene and Mary Garner are residing in the 2nd Ward with their three children in the 1895 Iowa Census. A house at this address also appears on the 1894 Sanborn Map. Eugene was working as a laborer in 1895 according to the census and by 1899 was deceased. Mary continued to reside here according to the 1899 city directory and 1913 city directory. Members of the Garner family held the property until December 1935 with Glenn Garner, an electrician, residing here with Mary in 1913 and during the early 1920s. At the time of Mary's death, Roy Garner, a son of Eugene and Mary, transferred the house to Henry Mueller. Henry and his wife Emma held it until 1949 when it was transferred to Otto and Helen Oberheu. They resided here according to telephone directories with Anna Oberheu in residence in the 1950s. The house stayed in Otto and Helen's ownership until 1972. William and Ruth Busching took ownership in 1974 and held it for at least 20 years.




