#### 7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1898 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built in the decades before and after 1900. No house appears on the 1894 Sanborn Map. Property transfer records show this parcel sold by Eliza and William Blain, a carpenter, to George E. Blain, a mason, in 1901. George held it until 1903 when it was likely sold with a house in place constructed by one or both Blains to Tabitha Cave, a recent widow. A construction date of ca. 1902 is consistent with the public records.

This house is an example of a vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house has a parged stone foundation with narrow clapboard-style vinyl siding on the walls. A low-pitched hipped roof has a flattened peak with no dormers and narrow eaves. A low-pitched hipped porch extends across the front with a low-pitched tympanum above the centered entrance steps. The porch has a concrete foundation, closed balustrade covered with matching siding, and four square columns evenly space along the front. Fenestration throughout the house includes various sizes of 1/1 double-hung windows and casement windows, some of which have been replaced and/or resized.

A detached frame single-bay garage is located southwest of the house. It has a front-gable roof, beveled wood siding, cornerboard trim, exposed rafters on the eaves and a replacement overhead door. The Assessor estimates the garage was built in 1930.

Alterations: vinyl siding (undated); porch changes (undated); windows (unknown); garage (1930).

#### 8. Significance

The Cave House at 315 5<sup>th</sup> St NW was built in ca. 1902 and is an example of a vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. It is typical of many other such houses built as working class housing the decades before and after the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C and the garage is considered noncontributing.

Property transfer records show this parcel sold by Eliza and William Blain, a carpenter, to George E. Blain, a mason, in 1901. George held it until 1903 when it was likely sold with a house in place constructed by one or both Blains to Tabitha Cave, widow of Henry H. Cave. Her husband died in 1901 and she held the house until 1923 when she passed it to Bert Cave and his wife Lena. Bert was employed as a carpenter. Bert and his family held the property until April 1946 when it was transferred to Lydia Ingersoll, a widow. She held the property and resided here for a number of years. It was transferred to Everett Ingersoll in 1986.



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
