7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1908 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built during 1880s and 1920s period. A house at this address appears in the 1913 city directory listings as occupied by Mrs. Henry Cave, a tenant widow. It is likely that she was a tenant of Anna Hoper and her husband who held this property from 1905 until 1913 or Louis and Minnie Hoper who held this property briefly from February to December 1913. Together these public records suggest that the house was erected between 1905 and 1913 making a ca. 1908 date feasible.

This 2-story frame house is an example of a vernacular Front-Gabled Roof, 2-story house form built in Waverly from the 1880s through the 1920s. The house has an early rock-faced concrete block foundation with asbestos shingle siding. A moderate-pitched front-gabled roof has broad gabled wall dormers on the south and north slopes. A small 1-story hipped roof addition is on the south façade set back along the wall. The enclosed porch spans the full front and has been enclosed with a matching block foundation (original), shingle siding, and 1/1 windows. The original roof supports have been covered. The entrance is centered with a pair of windows to each side. Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced single and paired 1/1 double-hung windows.

A detached frame 1-story garage is located at the rear of the property. It has vertical wood board siding on most the walls with one façade clad in narrow clapboard-style vinyl siding. According to the Assessor's records, the building was constructed at the same time the house was built in 1908. The garage retains its by-pass doors fabricated of wide vertical boards.

Alterations: asbestos siding (undated); porch enclosure (undated); garage vinyl siding (undated).

8. Significance

The Hoper Rental Dwelling at 415 5th St NW was built in ca. 1908 as a rental house and is an example of a vernacular Front-Gabled Roof, 2-Story house form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C. The garage is considered noncontributing.

Property transfer records show Lots 7 and 8 in Block 51 of Harmon and LeValley Addition acquired members of the Hoper family beginning in 1905 and continuing ownership through December 1913. A house at this address appears in the 1913 city directory listings as occupied by Mrs. Henry Cave, a tenant widow. It is likely that she was a tenant of either Anna Hoper and her husband who held this property from 1905 until 1913 or Louis and Minnie Hoper who held this property briefly from February to December 1913. The house features an early example of local concrete block from ca. 1905 for its foundation.

The house passed to Lena Bessmer and her husband in 1913 and to Bertha Propp in 1916. It does not appear that Bertha resided at the house. In 1940 she sold it to William and Elda Martin. In 1948 it was

transferred to Arlo and Ruth Courbat who resided there during the 1950s. In 1959 it was sold to Dickey and Bessie Gray who owned it until 1966.


