### 7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1898 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from the 1890s through the 1910s. A house at this address appears in the 1913 city directory listings as occupied by Otto Menti and his wife Nellie. The couple acquired the property in March 1912 from Elizabeth Thompson. It is likely the house pre-dates their purchase as the foundation is made of stone – a features o Waverly houses usually built prior to 1905. Together these public records suggest that the house was erected in ca. 1905.

This 1-story frame house is an example of a vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form that was popular in lowa from the 1890s to the 1910s. The house has a parged stone foundation with wide asbestos shingle siding (Transite siding). A low-pitched hipped roof has a flattened peak with no dormers and narrow width eaves. A small open flat-roof porch is centered on the front and has square posts for the roof supports, a replacement balustrade composed of diagonal "X" boards, and lattice skirting. Original scroll-cut brackets are at the porch rough edge at the house. Fenestration throughout the house includes widely spaced single and paired narrow 1/1 double-hung windows of various sizes.

A detached frame garage is located east of the main house. It has a moderate-pitched front-gabled roof with wide vinyl siding. The double-wide overhead door opens onto 6<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. According to Assessor records, the garage was built in 1997.

Alterations: asbestos siding (undated); porch enclosure and concrete block installation (undated).

### 8. Significance

The Menti House at 524 5<sup>th</sup> St NW was built in ca. 1905 is an example of a vernacular Pyramidal or Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. This small house form was built for several decades at the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century in the Harmon and LeValley Addition. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C and the garage is considered noncontributing.

Property transfer records show Elizabeth Thompson, a widow, sold this lot to Otto Menti in March 1912. It is likely the house was built before 1905 during Thompson's ownership. A house at this address appears in the 1913 city directory listings Otto Menti and his wife Nellie residing there after the couple acquired the property in March 1912 from Elizabeth Thompson. Otto worked at the Waverly Gas Company in 1913. In March 1915 the house was transferred to Ida Corlett. Ida and her husband, Curtis, resided here through 1939 with Curtis working at the Grassfield Shoe Store on East Bremer Ave. initially. In August 1939 the property was transferred to Herman and Anna Scharp where the couple resided. Anna maintained ownership into the 1970s with house transferred in 1972 to Harold and Vera Collins who held the property until the mid 1990s.




