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7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1941 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form is typical of infill houses in Waverly built during the late 1930s and 1940s. In April 1941 Bremer County Property Transfer Records show E.H. Meyer acquiring this parcel from Hugh Mooney. The 1943 Sanborn Map depicts the house in place. Therefore, a construction date of ca. 1942 is consistent with public records for this property.

This 1½-story frame house is an example of a Cape Cod, Side-Gable Roof house form that became popular in the Midwest in the 1930s and continued to be built for three decades. In this case the house has the classic symmetrical form with a concrete foundation and wide wood clapboard siding. The house has a steep side-gable roof with narrow eaves and two gabled attic dormers on the front slope. An enclosed entrance bay is centered on the front and like the dormers and main roof, has a steeply pitched gable roof with returning cornices. A small gabled entrance hood was added over the front door in ca. 2005. Fenestration includes single and paired six-light casement windows (dormers and north façade, kitchen) and eight-light casement windows (front façade). Applied louvered shutters are on the first floor, front façade. A six-light octagonal window is centered beneath the peak of the gabled entrance bay. An exposed brick fireplace is centered on the south gable end.

The property has a single-car attached garage at the rear that features a concrete deck on the roof. The walls are clad in matching wood clapboard siding and the driveway extends along the north side of the house where it opens onto 6th St NW. The attached garage was built at the same time the main house was erected in 1942.

Alterations: entrance hood (2005); Replacement concrete steps (2004).

8. Significance

The Edward and Ida Meyer House at 215 6th St NW was built in ca. 1942 and is a well-preserved example of a Cape Cod, Side-Gable Roof house. Plans for such designs were frequently available in pattern books and plan bureaus that sought to provide creative small and moderate size house designs for construction during World War II when building materials were in short supply. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

Property transfer records show Edward H. Meyer acquired this property in April 1941 Bremer from Hugh Mooney. News accounts in the *Bremer County Independent* in 5/28/1941 and 1/9/1942 describe the house under construction and completed. Edward and his wife Ida moved in a short time later. Edward H. Meyer owned Meyer Pharmacy in Waverly.

In 1972 Edward's estate passed the property to his widow. She held the property until 1987 when it was sold to Beryl and Susan Jordan, who remain owners of the house in 2013.



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
