7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1926 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form is typical of small houses built in Waverly from the 1910s to the 1920s as infill housing. Bremer County Property Transfer Records show August Zimmermann acquiring the property in 1918 and transferring it to his wife Ernestine the following year. August died in 1920. Ernestine Zimmermann sold the south half of the two-lot parcel in Block 59 of M. N. LeValley's Addition in 1927 to Cora Ebert. The 1926 telephone book shows Ernestine residing immediately to the north at 323 6th St NW and by 1931, George Ebert (Cora's father) was listed at 317 6th St NW. A construction date of ca. 1926 is consistent with public records for this property.

This 1-story frame house is an example of a Bungalow/Craftsman Style Front-Gable house form. The house has a reddish-brown colored clay tile block foundation with asbestos shingle siding on the walls. The house has a moderate pitched front-gabled roof with exposed rafter tails along the sloping sides and on the shed roofed oriel (rectilinear bay window) on the south façade. The enclosed front-porch has a broad, low-pitched gable roof with a continuous row of 3/1 double-hung windows on the front and pairs of similar windows on the north and south sides. The upper sashes have vertical lights typical of Craftsman Style windows. The front door has three tall and narrow vertical lights in the upper sash as well. Fenestration elsewhere includes single and paired windows with similar configurations. In some instances such as the oriel, the upper sash has a shorter height than the lower window but the vertical lights remain. The only other feature window group is beneath the peak of the front gable. Here a single, wide segmental molding is above three windows, each with multi-light vertical sash. A detached double-bay hipped roof garage is at the rear southwest of the house. It has narrow wood clapboard siding, narrow cornerboards and a replacement double-wide overhead garage door. A shed-roofed addition is on the rear. It was built in 1926 according to Assessor records.

Alterations: garage door replaced (undated); asbestos siding (undated).

8. Significance

The Ebert-Wendt House at 317 6th St NW was built in ca. 1927 and is an example of a Bungalow/Craftsman Style Front-Gable house form. The house and garage qualify for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

Property transfer records show August Zimmermann acquiring the property in 1918 and transferring it to his wife Ernestine the following year. August, the minister at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, died in 1920. Ernestine Zimmermann sold the south half of the two-lot parcel in Block 59 of M. N. LeValley's Addition in 1927 to Cora Ebert. The 1926 and 1931 telephone books show Ernestine residing immediately to the north at 323/333 6th St NW. By 1931, George Ebert (Cora's father) was listed at 317 6th St NW. George worked as a building contractor and likely handled the construction of this house.

In October 1935, Cora sold this house to Henry and Emma Wendt. In 1946 the house passed from their heirs to Harrison and Mayme Parrott.




