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7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1898 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built from the 1890s to the 1910s. The property was transferred to J. Belle (Cady) Kenney from her father Chester Cady's estate in 1903. She and her husband, Frank Kenney, built this house on the property in 1903. On 5/7/1903 the *Bremer County Independent* reports that "Frank Kenney has the foundation wall completed for a new house on the lot just south of Mrs. Cady's house in the Second ward." This is a reference to the south half of Lots 1 & 2 in Block 58. Three years later in 1906, J. Belle Kenney transferred the house to August Selinsky and on to Atlana M. Vosseller two years later. The 1913 city directory shows the house at 415 Aspen St (6th St NW) occupied by Mrs. A.M. Vosseller. These public records suggest the house was constructed in late 1903.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular Side-Gable Roof, 1½-story house form that was popular from the 1890s to 1910s in Waverly. This example has a parged stone foundation with asbestos shingle siding on the walls. The house has a broad, moderate-pitched side gable roof with a steeply pitched wall-dormer with returning cornices at the far right of the front façade. A low-pitched shed roof 1-story wing extends on the south façade. The house has a small gabled entrance porch centered on the front façade added between 2009 and 2011. Square posts and replacement balustrades line the north and south sides. Fenestration includes 1/1 double-hung windows of various sizes. On the front façade, the windows take the form of cottage style windows with larger single-light lower sash and narrow, horizontal single-light upper sash. These windows flank the entrance, are centered in the wall dormer peak, and façade the south. On the north façade, large vertical sash surrounded by stained glass squares are placed at stair-step heights. The 1-story wing has continuous rows of 1/1 sash lining the walls and facing onto the deck.

The property has a frame garage single-bay garage located along the west property line. It has a front-gable roof and was estimated to have been built in 1942.

Alterations: Transite (asbestos) siding, undated; entrance porch (ca. 2010); stone foundation parging, undated.

8. Significance

The Frank and J.Belle Kenney House at 415 6th St NW was built in ca. 1903 and is an example of a Side-Gable Roof 1½-story house form that became popular in the decades before and after to the turn of the 20th century. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C. The garage is considered noncontributing.

Research on the background ownership for this property was completed by Waverly Historic Preservation Commission member, Mary Meyer. Property transfer records show that J.Belle Kenney acquired this parcel by quit claim deed from her mother Brittania Cady in 1903 following the death of her father, Chester C. Cady. Chester died on 2/13/1903 after having suffered a stroke four years earlier. Two quit claim deed transfers occur in 1903 after Chester's death and the end result is that Britannia, the widow, owns the N 1/2 of Lots 1 and 2 and Belle, the daughter, owns the S 1/2. Brittania Cady resided on the north half of Lots 1 and 2 in Block 58 and her daughter and son-in-law built a new house on the south half of the lots during 1903. Belle was the only child of Chester C. and Brittania Wheeler Cady. Both Frank Kenney and his father-in-law owned small farms just northwest of the Waverly city limits. Chester, however, had purchased Lots 1 and 2 of Block 58 shortly after he came to Waverly in 1866 and lived there for all but eight years when he was farming, according to his obituary. He was listed in various census records as a brick mason or plasterer.

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On 5/7/1903 the *Bremer County Independent* reported that "Frank Kenney has the foundation wall completed for a new house on the lot just south of Mrs. Cady's house in the Second ward." This reference is for the house at 415 6th St NW south of the now vacant lot where Mrs. Cady's house stood at the time. Frank and Belle sold their house in 1906 and Britannia Cady sold her house in 1908. They all ended up in Minneapolis where Frank was selling real estate.

According to property transfer records, the parcel was transferred from J.Belle Kenney to August Selinsky in 1906 and on to Atlana M. Vosseller two years later. The 1913 city directory shows the house at 415 Aspen St (6th St NW) occupied by Mrs. A.M. Vosseller, a widow, at the time. In 1921, the property passed from Vosseller to Martin Clary who held it until December 1925. He transferred it to F.H. Hartmann. It passed from the Hartmann family to Edward and Bertha Nacke in 1945. In 1973, Bertha passed the property to Roman and Shirley Fuerstenberg.

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
