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St. John, Del and Ella, House	Bremer
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7. Description

This 2-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1907 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house has a stone foundation suggesting it was built somewhat earlier closer to the turn of the 20th century. By 1913 the house was occupied by Del and Ella St. John.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular 2-story Cross-Gable Roof house form. The house has a stone foundation with narrow-width clapboard style vinyl siding. The house may have originally had a Front-Gable and Wing form but now has a moderate-pitched side-gable roof with an intersecting front-gable section centered on the front façade. A gable wall dormer is on the front slope to the right of the center section. A small entrance porch with a front gable roof is set in the right-hand ell. It has replacement turned posts, a low wood deck, and a wrought iron balustrade. A 1-story projecting bay with a gable roof is centered on the center section. No entrances or porches are located in the left-hand ell.

Fenestration includes 1/1 double-hung windows of various sizes and shapes in singles and pairs. The exception are the windows in the south wing, lower level that are pairs of tall windows with twin lights in the short upper sash. Windows on the upper level of the south wing may be porches of a sleeping porch. The garage at the rear of the property is frame construction with matching vinyl siding. It has a double bay with a low-pitched front gable roof. According to Assessor records it was constructed in 1984.

Alterations: addition of a siding (unknown dated) and porch alterations (unknown date).

8. Significance

The St. John House at 400 1st Street SE is an example of a vernacular 2-story Cross-Gable Roof house form built at the turn of the 20th century. The design of the house and its additions suggests it may have originally been constructed as a Front-Gable-and Wing and had a later addition to give it its current form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.

By 1913 the house was occupied by Del and Ella St. John. Del worked as manager for the Corn Belt Telephone Company. A second occupant at this address was Addie Shepherd, a widow. It is not known whether she was a family member or a tenant.

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


