

#### 7. Description

This 2-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1920 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The design of the house suggests it was likely built between ca. 1910 and ca. 1930. The house appears on the 1927 Sanborn Map.

This frame house is an example of a 2-story Bungalow Style house form. The house has a broad, side-gable roof with a wide shedroofed dormer centered on the front slope and a matching dormer on the rear slope. That front roof slope extends over a porch across the front. Sometime during the past few decades, the porch has been modified with the removal of its wood deck, columns, balustrade and steps and the addition of a concrete



patio, new square posts extending to ground level, and concrete steps set under the roof.

The house has a rock-faced concrete block foundation with medium-width clapboard-style vinyl siding on the walls. A rear 1-story gable roofed L-shaped wing clad in matching vinyl siding includes a small single-bay garage that appears on the 1927 depiction of the house (above). The open porch in this wing is now enclosed with 1/1 windows and a closed balustrade clad in matching siding. This garage wing appears to be one of the earliest attached garages in the neighborhood.

Fenestration includes 1/1 double-hung windows of various sizes and shapes in singles and groups. A group of three large windows are to the left of the front entrance and two pair of windows is in the shed dormer. An exception is the horizontal window with six vertical lights suggesting the house may have originally had double-hung windows with vertical multi-light upper sash. Square windows in the gable peaks have been replaced with louvered vents.

Alterations: addition of a siding (unknown dated) and porch alterations (unknown date).

#### 8. Significance

The house at 401 1<sup>st</sup> Street SE is an example of a 2-story Bungalow Style house form built after World War I. The original occupants have not been identified. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.


