7. Description

This 1-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1956 according to Bremer County Assessor records. Telephone directories confirm that the owners first occupied this address between 1955 and 1957. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built during the mid to late-1950s.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular 1-story Ranch/Rambler house form. This variation has an attached garage set back along the south side and the main house divided into adjoining hipped roof sections. The design has an unusually narrow width for a Ranch/Rambler that makes this house suitably sized for this lot. The house has a poured concrete foundation, medium-width wood clapboard siding on the north half and board and batten siding on the south section of the front façade, and no ornamentation. The house has a low-pitched hipped roof with deep eaves. The front entrance at the center of the front façade is set back in a deep alcove allowing the wide eave to form a protected entrance.

Fenestration includes a Chicago Window group to the immediate left of the front door. The window group includes a large, single-light horizontal fixed-sash flanked by narrow single-light casement windows. Narrow single-light casement windows are in groups of three and pairs elsewhere on the house with pairs of horizontal sash in the south end. Single-light sash are stacked in a group of three in the recessed wall adjacent to the front entrance. A second similar entrance is located facing the street in the adjoining hipped roof section next to the single-bay garage. The wood and glass paneled overhead door may be the original overhead door.

Alterations: no major changes identified except for shutters and entrance balustrade (both undated).

8. Significance

The Arthur and Irene Schultsmeyer House at 402 1st Street SE is an example of a well-preserved vernacular 1-story Ranch/Rambler house design from the post-World War II period. It is typical of houses built as in-fill housing during this period. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.

Arthur and Irene Schultsmeyer were the first occupants of this house between 1955 and 1957 according to telephone directories. Arthur operated Schultsmeyer's Store, a ladies' apparel and drygoods store at 123 E. Bremer Avenue. The motto for the store in 1959 was "Waverly's Store of Quality, Style and Value."


