#### 7. Description

This 1-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1935 according to Bremer County Assessor records. However, the 1927 Sanborn Map shows the building already in place. This is the first map depicting this portion of the neighborhood. The address is listed as occupied in the 1899 and 1913 city directories, making it likely that it dates from ca. 1900.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular 1-story Gable-Front-and-Wing house form. It has a low-pitched side-gable roof with a low-pitched shed-roofed porch tucked in the left-hand ell. The house has a concrete block foundation with a stucco finish and clapboard-style vinyl siding on the walls. The porch projects slightly forward of the front façade and is enclosed with matching siding and a continuous row of 1/1 windows above the balustrade. The skirting panels consist of vertical lattice applied to plywood. A 1-story addition dated by the Assessor records to the 1950s is setback along the south façade. It has a poured concrete foundation, matching vinyl siding, and a very low-pitched hipped roof.

Fenestration includes single and paired double-hung windows. The 1/1 sash in the front-gable wing each have pediment lintels suggesting the house's original construction might pre-date 1900. A pair of sash are evenly spaced in the gable end with no window in the peak. Windows in the new addition have flat lintels. The house has a detached1-story front-gable carriage barn. It has beveled wood siding with a wide cornice and narrow eaves. An upper level appears to have been originally accessed by a gable door for hay storage. Sometime after its construction, the garage was lengthened by approximately six feet with the addition of a shed extension built on the east end presumably to accommodate the length of a longer automobile. The carriage barn was built in 1918 according to Bremer County Assessor records suggesting this may have been the date for the house as well.

Alterations: south addition (ca. 1950s); porch enclosure (undated) and vinyl siding (undated).

#### 8. Significance

The J.C. Hodges at 414 1<sup>st</sup> Street SE is an example of a vernacular 1-story Gable-Front-and-Wing house form. The house was part of the main wave of homebuilding in the neighborhood that extended from the 1880s through the post-World War I years. The house and carriage barn qualify for the National Register of Historic Places as contributing resources to the historic district under Criterion C.

This address is listed in the 1899 city directory as occupied by J.C. Hodges, a bridge builder. By the time the 1913 city directory as occupied by U.N. and Hannah Stotts. U.N. Stotts was employed as the agent for the Singer Sewing Machine Co. at that time. It is not certain whether this house is the one present in 1927 or built sometime between 1913 and 1927. The Stotts are not listed as owners of the property in the Property Transfer records but may have been tenants. Owners of the property after 1894 included Ralph and Mary Potter (1894); Albert M. Potter (1894-1901); Mary Potter (1903); Theodore Pockels (1902-1903); D.A. Long (1903-1906); Jessie Potter (1906-1913); and Isaac Woodring (1912-1919).



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
