7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1940 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with similar houses in Waverly built using this form from the end of the Civil War through the turn of the early 20th century. The 1913 city directory shows the address occupied by a dwelling suggesting that this house or an earlier dwelling was in place at that time. It is possible given this house form that it was built as early as ca. 1910 and as late as ca. 1940.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular Gable Front and Wing, 2-story house form. The house has a parged stone foundation with medium-width clapboard-style vinyl siding. The house has an L-shaped plan with an intersecting gable roof with flared eaves. A pair of gabled attic dormers with flared eaves is on the east slope and a larger flared roof gable dormer is on the front roof slope that extends over the original open porch that is tucked in the left-hand ell. That porch is now enclosed with infill operable horizontal folding windows, fixed sash transoms, and matching vinyl siding. Exposed rafters line the front eave of the porch and the original porch skirting retains the vertical board design. The house has an exposed brick chimney on the west façade. Fenestration in the house includes widely spaced 1/1 double-hung windows and smaller 1/1 windows in the dormers, including a group of three windows in the front dormer.

A detached frame garage with matching siding, a low-pitched side gable roof, and twin overhead doors faces the east-west alley. According to assessor records, the garage was built in 1991.

Alterations: vinyl siding (undated); garage replacement (1991).

8. Significance

The house at 315 2nd Avenue SE built in ca. 1940 is an example of a Gable Front and Wing, 2-story house form. This late example of this form has features typical of later examples of this design including flared gable roof lines on the house and dormers, vertical slats in the porch skirting, and an exposed chimney. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.


