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7. Description

This 1-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1959 according to Bremer County Assessor records. City directories and telephone directories show it listed between 1959 and 1961. The house form and style are consistent with houses in Waverly built during the mid to late-1950s. Based in this evidence, the house was likely constructed in ca. 1959.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular 1-story Ranch/Rambler house form. This variation has an attached single-car garage along the east side and the remainder of the house forming a shallow L-shaped plan. The house has a concrete block foundation, wide-width clapboard-style aluminum siding and no ornamentation. The house has a very low-pitched hipped roof with deep eaves. A recessed section formed by the projecting garage and L-shaped plan forms a recessed entrance porch. A portion of this are has now been filled with screen walls. The front entrance is set on the left side of the recessed porch area with a pair of large square fixed sash filling the balance of the porch's rear wall. Windows elsewhere include casement style sash in groups.

Alterations: siding (undated); screen porch (undated); garage door (undated).

8. Significance

The Richard and Agnes Platte House at 110 3rd Ave SE is an example of a vernacular 1-story Ranch/Rambler house design from the post-World War II period. It is typical of houses built as in-fill housing during this period. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criterion C.

The Plattes began living here in ca. 1960. Richard worked for the Bremer Elevator at the time.



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

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
