7. Description

This 2-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1910 according to Bremer County Assessor records. Property transfer records show this lot acquired by Frances Schlutsmeyer in 1889 from W.M. Woodford as part of a four lot parcel – Lots 5,6,7,& 8. In the 1899 city directory, the Henry and Francis Schlutsmeyer family were residing a half block to the west along 3rd Street SE. By 1913 the city directory listed Henry and Francis Schlutsmeyer living at 309 Madison St. (3rd Ave. SE) with their son Ernest and his wife, Beulah, next door at 315 3rd Ave SE. No residence is listed next door at #317. The Assessor's records indicate an estimated construction date for the garage of 1918. This suggest likely that the house was likely erected sometime before 1913 and 1918, making ca.1915 a likely date of construction.

The house at 317 3rd Ave. SE is an example of a Hipped-Roof 2-story house form popularly known as "American-Four Square." It has a low-pitched hipped roof with a hipped roof attic dormer on the front slope. A porch spans the front façade and has a broad, low-pitched gable roof porch. A flat-roofed 1-story wing is setback along the east façade. The main house has a rock-faced concrete block foundation with narrow-width clapboard style aluminum siding on the walls and the dormer. The porch has a low-level matching foundation with piers at the outer corners and a balustrade clad in matching siding that extends to the foundation level. The porch entrance is opposite the front door on the right side. Fenestration includes various sized single and paired 1/1 double-hung windows. The dormer window opening has been replaced with a panel containing two vents.

The house has a detached 1-story hipped-roof garage located northeast of the main building along the alley. It was built in 1918 according to Bremer County Assessor records.

Alterations: siding (undated); porch changes (undated); foundation painted (bet. 2009 and 2011)

8. Significance

The house at 317 3rd Ave. SE is an example of a Hipped-Roof 2-story house form popularly known as "American-Four Square." The house was part of the main wave of homebuilding in the neighborhood that extended from the 1880s through World War I. The house and garage qualify for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource in the historic district under Criteria A and C.

Property transfer records show the property acquired by Frances [sic] Schlutsmeyer in 1889 from W.M. Woodford as part of a four lot parcel – Lots 5, 6, 7, & 8. In ca, 1900, 1906, and 1910, three houses were built on portions of Lots 5, 6 and 7. Francis and her husband, Henry, continued to own the property in 1920 making it likely that the house was built as a rental unit adjacent to houses occupied by his own family and that of his son, Ernest.







