

7. Description

This 2-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1888 according to Bremer County Assessor records. However, the design for the house is likely 40 years newer. Property transfer records show the property held by Fred and Amelia Schlutsmeyer prior to the sale in 1919 of the south 50 feet of the lot. The transfer was done by Amelia Schlutsmeyer on behalf of the estate in 1919, three years after her husband's death. On March 1, 1917, newspaper accounts list Mrs. Fred Schlutsmeyer as building a "fine modern residence on her lot in the Fourth Ward during the coming season" making this house the likely candidate. Together, this information strongly suggests a construction date of ca. 1917 rather than 1888, which may have been the year for the house that it replaced.

This 2-story frame house is an example of a vernacular Gambrel Cottage house form. It has a moderate pitched gambrel roof with the gambrel end facing the street. The house has simple returning cornices and narrow eaves with gabled attic dormers on the north and south slopes. A broad front-gable roof porch



spans the full front façade with steps offset on the south end. The balustrade is composed of narrow slats that extend to ground level. Full height battered piers are at the outer corners and extend to ground level. The house is depicted in the 1927 Sanborn Map (above).

The Schlutsmeyer House has a parged concrete block foundation with wide Transite[™] (asbestos shingles) for wall cladding. The same cladding is used for the dormers. Fenestration includes various sized 1/1 double-hung windows in singles and pairs. On the front façade a pair of windows is in the gambrel peak with a single window to the right of the off-set entrance.

The house has a detached 1-story double-bay garage located northwest of the house and accessed from 3rd Street SE. Built in 1940 according to Bremer County Assessor records, it has a low-pitched hipped roof with matching Transite™ shingle siding.

Alterations: porch balustrade (undated); Transite™ siding (undated); garage built (1940).

8. Significance

The Schlutsmeyer House is an example of a vernacular Gambrel Cottage house form. The house was part of the main wave of homebuilding in the neighborhood that extended from the 1880s through World War I. Its owner, Amelia Schlutsmeyer, built the house as a widow and likely held it as a rental property. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource in the historic district under Criteria A and C. The garage is considered noncontributing.

According to property transfer records, Fred and Amelia Schlutsmeyer owned this property beginning in 1877. Fred died in 1916 and a year later, the March 1, 1917 newspaper reported that Mrs. Fred Schlutsmeyer was building a house in the 4th Ward on the site of a house currently occupied by W.H.

Pockels and his mother (see article below). The 1913 city directory lists the Pockels residing at 416 S. Harmon Street (416 3rd St. SE). Amelia "Mollie" Schlutsmeyer continued to develop the balance of this lot as a widow, when in 1919 she sold off the south 50 feet to Henry Pothast for the construction of another house while retaining the house at 416 3rd St. SE on the balance of Lot 3 for herself. It is unclear whether she rented the house or resided there herself.

Mrs. Fred Schlutsmeyer will erect a fine modern residence on her lot in the Fourth ward the coming season. W. H. Pockels and his mother, who have occupied the house now on the lot, will move into the Mrs. Jennie Case house in the same ward as soon as H. L. Grawe is able to move on to his place in the northern part of town.


