

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### 7. Description

This 2-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1900 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The 1894 *Atlas of Bremer County* includes a house with a similar footprint. The 1913 city directory lists Eli and Sophie Behrens residing at 423 S. Harmon Street (3<sup>rd</sup> St. SE) suggesting that a house was in place at this time. The 1927 Sanborn Map clearly includes this house. Together, this information suggests a construction date of ca. 1895 or slightly earlier for the original building rather than the Assessor estimate of 1900.

This frame house depicted in the Sanborn Map for 1927 (at right) is an example of a vernacular Gable-Front-and-Wing house form. It has L-plan for the original building and since it was built appears to have had a 2-story front-gable wing and a 1-story side-gable wing with low pitched gable roof slopes. These slopes suggest that they may have been flattened at some point in the life of the building. The house has narrow eaves with no cornice and no dormers.



A ventilated cupola is centered on the ridge of the 1-story wing.

The original porch that filled the right-hand ell has been removed and replaced with a small enclosed entrance vestibule and flat roof overhang supported by a decorative wrought iron post. The house has a concrete block foundation with narrow clapboard style vinyl siding for wall cladding. The enclosed entrance vestibule is clad with the same finish. Fenestration includes various sized 6/6 double-hung windows widely spaced on the walls. The 1-story wing has a feature window consisting of narrow 6/6 units flanking a large 20-light fixed sash. Applied shutters are at all of the openings. The house has a single-bay garage in the basement level accessed from the rear of the 2-story wing.

Alterations: vinyl siding (between 2009 and 2011); porch removal (undated); replacement windows (undated, at the time the previous aluminum siding was installed).

#### 8. Significance

The Behrens House at 423 is an example of a vernacular Gable-Front-and-Wing house form. The house was part of the main wave of homebuilding in the neighborhood that extended from the 1880s through World War I. Its first owners have not been identified but Eli and Sophie Behrens resided here before World War I. The house is considered eligible for the National Register of Historic Places for the historic district as a contributing resource.

Available property transfer records do not provide a clear record of early ownership. In 1913 city directories show the house occupied by Eli and Sophie Behrens. Eli was a partner in the firm, Behrens & Kaiser Garage located at 110 W. Bremer Avenue. In later years the Behrens Garage survived but it was no longer operated by Eli.






