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7. Description

This 1½-story single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1948 according to Bremer County Assessor records. Its design is typical of patternbook houses constructed during and after World War II. It is in place on the 1927 Sanborn Map updated to 1952. Property transfer records show transfers during the 1920s and 1930s but in 1947 show the parcel transferred to Anna Clapham. Together, this information suggests a construction date of ca. 1948 for the house though further research is recommended to confirm this date.

This frame house is an example of a vernacular Front-Gable, 1½-Story house form. The roof plan includes a broad, steeply pitched front-gable and no eaves. The house has no entrance porch or door hood. The house and garage appear on the 1927 Sanborn Map containing updates through 1952 (right).

The Clapham House has a smooth finished concrete block foundation with wide asbestos shingle (Transite™) siding for the walls. The intersecting gable roof has narrow eaves. Fenestration for the house includes a mixture single and paired 1/1 double-hung windows of various

sizes. The front façade has the entrance off-set to the right and topped by a pair of smaller 1/1 double-hung units.

A double-bay garage located northwest of the house appears to have been constructed at the same time the house was built or slightly earlier. Assessor records give it a date of 1908. The garage has a hipped roof with flared eaves, narrow wood clapboard siding and corner board trim, and a replacement overhead door. The garage opens onto 4th Avenue SE.

Alterations: garage door (undated).

8. Significance

The Clapham House at 215 4th Avenue SE is an example of a vernacular Front-Gable, 1½-Story house form built in ca. 1948. The house was built during the last wave of homebuilding that extended from the 1930s through the post World War II years in the neighborhood. Anna Clapham is believed to be the house's first owner. The house retains its original simple form and maybe an instance of the use of Transite siding in new construction. The house is considered significant as a contributing resource in the surrounding historic district under National Register Criteria A and C.



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
