Any tree hanging over the sidewalk or street will be trimmed in accordance to the Waverly City Code which states: "Trees should be trimmed so that all branches will be at least(16) feet above the surface of the street and at least (8) eight feet above the sidewalks." Trees that are on private property are also covered by the same City code in terms of clearance. Please have vehicles removed from under the trees during this time. Thank you for your cooperation.
