In 1968 the City of Waverly acquired the 5 blocks of land South of the Fire Station along the riverside on the East side of 1st St. SW. In 1970 a shelter was built and in 1979 the park was named South Riverside Park. A playground was installed in 2003. This park is popular for fishing along the river and walkers stopping as they stroll through to sit on one of the benches to enjoy the view. The area North of the park is also the home of the Waverly Farmers Market and the new Pavilion and Exchange building that will be completed and available for public use very soon.
