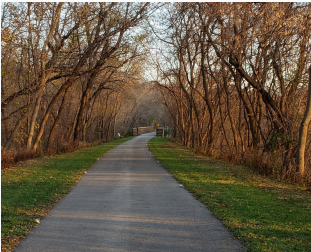

WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS

In the event of snowfall, all trails in town are cleared, **except:** Brookwood Park, and the trail South of Red Cedar Park along 8th St. SE. Additionally, the Rail Trail from the trail head behind Kwik Star East traveling East on the trail to Hwy. 63 at the 7 mile mark. These portions of the trail are not cleared to promote winter activities such as cross country skiing, snow shoeing, fat tire biking and more.



When there is a good accumulation of snow, staff will open the sledding hill at the Waverly Municipal Golf Course, Hole 1. Please watch for open or closed signs at the hill. If the hill is open, feel free to enjoy some good family fun.
