Places to Play: KOHLMANN PARK

Situated in the heart of Waverly along the banks of the Cedar River you will find one of our most scenic places to play; Kohlmann Park.

History of the park dates back to 1919. It connects the bike trail north and the downtown loop. The park features a lovely section of trail winding throughout, healthy trees, seasonal flower plantings, restrooms, and public shelters.

A unique feature of the park is the Amphitheater added to the park in 2014. The feature was designed by Iowa State Architecture students Ann Cashman and Darian Lue. The Amphitheater hosts summer band concerts, weddings, and other events each year.

In 2019, new safety surfacing was added to the park playground area. This has made the park a safe amenity for all to enjoy.

The annual Art Walk, Oktoberfest, and many other community events are held in Kohlmann Park each year.

Tree Replacement Program

Any Waverly address may take advantage of the tree replacement rebate program.

- 1. If they have had any type of tree removed with the City right-ofway (between the sidewalk and the curb).
- 2. If they have an Ash tree in the right-of-way that will be removed in the future.

Trees may be purchased by the public at Tiedt Nursery and Wells Hollow Landscaping. The program is a 50% rebate up to \$75 off the cost of each tree. The choices will be limited by current inventory. Maple trees are not included in the rebate program. Limit of 40 total trees to be rebated this year. Each purchaser may only buy two trees per address through the rebate program.

The dates of the program are September 23- November 4. There will be no sales after Monday, November 4, 2019. For more information call Leisure Services at 352-6263.
