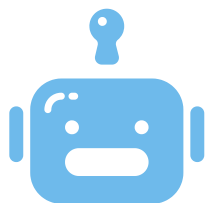

6:30-7:30 PM

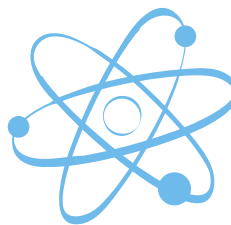

2:30-3:30 PM

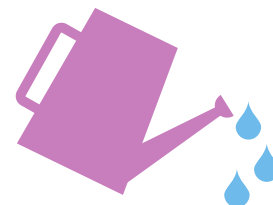
The Grout Museum will present live science demonstrations with the theme "Charge it Up"! These programs are sponsored by the Greater Waverly Kiwanis Club.



GARDENING IN 2020

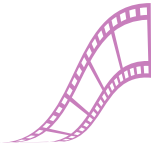
Thursday, March 26

Bottom right: Clay Day continues to be a Wednesday afternoon hit with all ages!

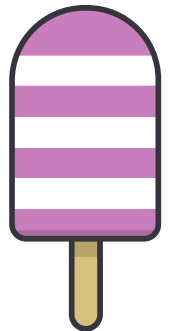


THINKING ABOUT SUMMER...



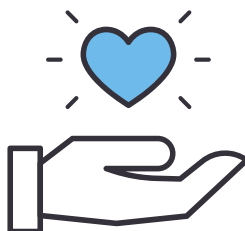
