LIBRARY NOW OPEN WITH NO APPOINTMENT NECESSARY

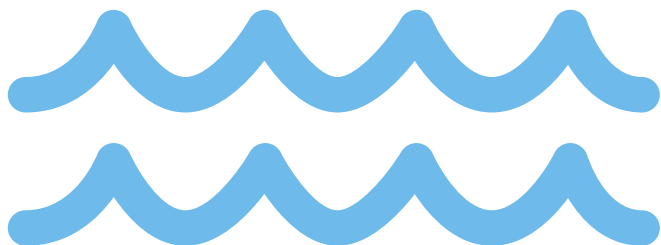

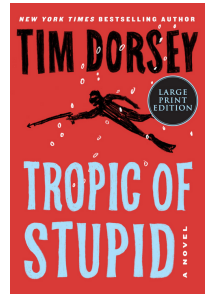
UPCOMING LIBRARY CLOSURE
