Tuesday, March 15 at 6:30 PM

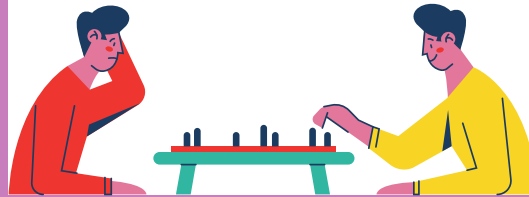
It's time for our quarterly in-person trivia event, and this time, it's all about the music. Join us for audio rounds galore to test your musical prowess!

Saturdays at 10:30 AM

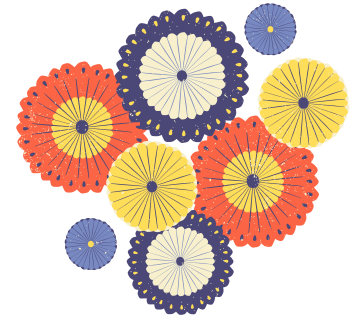

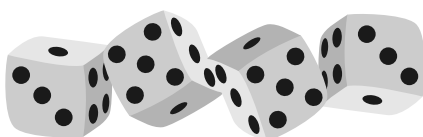
## BOARD GAME PASSPORT

We've got a new, ongoing program for you, and it's all about the board games! Here's how the new Board Game Passport program works:

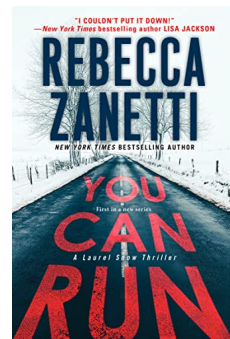
Step 1: Come to the library and fill out a short sign-up sheet. Receive your first passport card!
