#### What's your earliest library memory?

I remember riding my bike to the Public Library in Northwood, where I grew up, and standing in front of the shelf that held the entire Nancy Drew series, pulling one out at a time trying to make a decision. Another strong memory from when I was a kid -- my 5th grade teacher, Mrs. Erikson, read us one chapter a day of Where a Red Fern Grows, and I remember how much I loved listening to her read and couldn't wait to hear more of the story.

#### What would you be doing if you weren't a librarian?

I think I may have been a teacher. I imagined myself teaching, English literature, in some small college.

#### What's your favorite section in the library?

That's a tough one. I love the poetry section -- in the 800s. I love the art section -- in the 700s. I love the children's picture book section. I am still drawn to the art in the illustrations and the carefully chosen words. The local history collection is also a favorite of mine -- looking at photos of Waverly in the early days and reading about life in 1800's Iowa.

I have always loved authors Wendell Berry and Louise Erdrich. I love to read about the past, about rural America, about people in their communities.
