- **2.** Approval of the Last Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve the July 2017 meeting minutes by Von Blunt and seconded by Jane Wollenzien, motion carried.

- 4. Reports and Announcements: Commission reviewed the Traffic and Fuel Report for July 2017 as presented by Dale Guimond.
