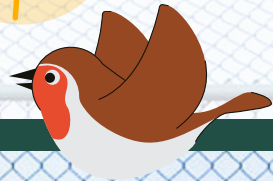
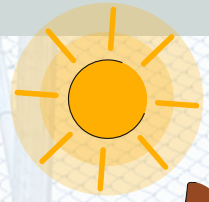

- Bring a ball, but be prepared to lose it.
- Keep an eye on your dog. Owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog (s) at all times.
- Dog treats and human food should NOT be brought into the park as it could cause aggression in other dogs.
- Humans MUST be 8 years of age or older to enter the park and 15 years of age to bring a dog to the park.
