

### TRAIL RULES AND REMINDERS

- Move off the trail or stay clear when stopped.
- Show respect for adjacent private property.
- No hunting or firearms allowed on trail or within 50 feet of trail.
- Trail users are encouraged to wear appropriate safety equipment, including helmets.
- When passing, say "on your left" or "passing".
- Pets should be leashed and picked up after.
- Keep the trail clean.
- The speed limit is 20 mph. Slow down when the trail is busy.
- Stay alert.
- Obey any posted signage.
- Signal turns or stops.
- Move to single file when an oncoming trail user approaches.


